TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM: This program is designed to provide students with the knowledge, skills, and attitudes necessary to become effective teachers. The program is structured to meet the needs of students who are working full-time or part-time, and who may have other commitments. The program is delivered through a combination of face-to-face and distance education methods.

The program is divided into two main components: the Bachelor of Education (BEd) and the Bachelor of Education (BEd) with a specialization in Early Childhood Education. The BEd program is a four-year program, and the BEd with a specialization in Early Childhood Education is a five-year program. The program is designed to be flexible, allowing students to complete their studies in a shorter or longer period of time, depending on their needs and circumstances. The program is also designed to be relevant to the needs of the Pacific region, with a focus on developing teachers who are able to work in diverse cultural contexts.
